Conditions:

- 1. At the discretion of the Village the applicant may be required to post a maintenance bond (cash, surety, or letter of credit) with the Village in an amount to be determined by the Village.
- 2. The applicant hereby agrees to repair the work area (street, sidewalk, right of way) in accordance with the Village Standard Utility Street and Sidewalk Trench Repair specification, and to leave the work area in as good or better condition as before work began.
- 3. If traffic control is required the applicant shall submit a traffic control plan to the Village for review before the commencement of any work. If the Village requires a traffic control officer to be on site, the applicant shall pay all costs associated with said officer. All traffic control shall meet the standard of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (OMUTCD) latest edition.
- 4. All construction shall conform to the Village of Pleasantville Construction Specifications, and Standard Drawings latest edition.



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- 5. The applicant shall notify the Village Service Superintendent 740-468-2237 no less than 48 hours before any work begins.
- 6. Any sewers, drains, waterlines, or other appurtenances damaged during the work shall be reported to the Village Service Superintendent 740-468-2237 and repaired to the Village's satisfaction at no cost to the Village.
- 7. The applicant shall be required to contact the Ohio Utilities Protection Service (OUPS).
- 8. The applicant shall furnish the Village with one set of "as-built" Record Drawings no later than 60 days after the work is completed.
- 9. Approved Right of Way Permit is valid for 3 months from the Date of Issuance.
- 10. Work may NOT begin until application is approved, and all fees paid and/or maintenance bond is provided. \$1,000.00 administrative penalty for failure to comply or work without an approved permit.
